AGENDA: Mike motioned to accept the agenda as presented, Angie 2nd, all in favor, motion carried 3-0.

CONSENT AGENDA: Angie motioned to approve the consent agenda, Mike 2nd, all in favor, motion carried 3-0.

GUESTS: Rose Mary Saunders – Review of bids for transmission line and discussion of options for the City

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT: presented a quote on a new truck for street equipment, sell our street sweeper that we don't use, sludge removal out of sewer ponds soon, set pole, electrical problems during storms, took 121 tires to landfill, cleaned up ballfield parking lot after city clean up, sold street lights, blown fuse, thinking of replacing a few poles – need to set a date first, replace street lights on Main, get tank cleaned and inspected, leak check on reservoir, presented quotes on reservoir work, Randy motioned to hire Jim with Suez for \$1,500 for cleaning and inspecting the reservoir, Mike 2nd, all in favor, motion carried 3-0.
